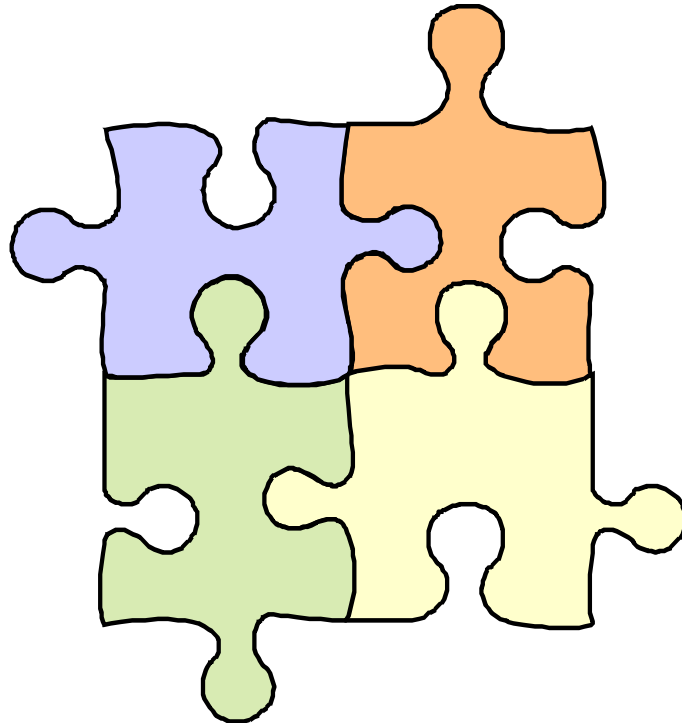

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HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

The Vocational Services Guide is provided as a public service to Ulster County residents by the Vocational Steering Committee. It is divided into five (5) sections. The first three sections provide information about specific programs and services available throughout Ulster County. The fourth section gives an alphabetical listing of agencies throughout the county, regardless of program or service. The fifth and final section is a recent addition. It provides general answers to frequently asked questions regarding vocational and educational services for individuals with or without disabilities.

Many agencies provide more than one program or service, so you may see them listed more than once within the first three sections. This guide will attempt to provide specific information regarding eligibility criteria, so that each individual can locate the resources that best suits his/her needs. In most cases, however, individuals can access more than one agency service or program at the same time.

Eligibility Criteria:

- *Must have a permanent disability which creates a significant barrier to gaining and maintaining suitable employment*
- *Permanent disabilities*
- *May include psychiatric, developmental, physical, learning disability or alcohol/substance abuse*
- *Applicants must demonstrate that symptoms are managed, that they are available to participate and committed to achieving employment*
- *Applicants must require VR services and benefit from VR services*

Services:

- *Vocational rehabilitation counseling*

- *Employment plan development with required education, training and support services leading to competitive employment*

Outcomes:

- *Individualized employment plan detailing services, providers, milestones and vocational objectives leading to employment goal. Employment goal reflects interests and abilities of consumer, aligned with local labor market.*

 - *Successful rehabilitation*
 - *Limited post-employment services*
 - *Supported Employment (Intensive and Follow Along)*
 - *Federal requirement of 90 days in employment for successful rehabilitation outcome.*

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Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can anyone in the community obtain supportive services through DSS?

The applicant must be in receipt of Temporary Assistance and actively participating in a program that DSS is aware of. This is necessary in order for DSS to approve the supportive services. The attendance in the program must also be verifiable. Once attendance is verified, DSS can provide the pre-approved supportive services. All supportive services are approved on a case by case basis.

2. Can anyone apply for financial aid to attend at SUNY Ulster?

Financial aid is potentially available to anyone pursuing a credit-based degree or certificate (matriculated students).

3. What types of services can the Resource Center for Accessible Living assist with?

We can assist with Medicaid, Medicare and other insurance plans, as well as with Social Security, SSI and SSD, and any issues affecting them.

4. Does Family of Woodstock cover the entire county? How much do their services cost?

Family of Woodstock covers all of Ulster County. Their services are free and voluntary.

5. Does an individual need to be referred by a clinician?

No. Individuals may self-refer if so desired, but clinicians may refer as well.
